

“Hepatitis C - Card game”



What you need:

Two decks of cards. One regular deck of cards and one deck of cards from www.hcvadvocate.org Titled “Hepatitis C”

Number of players:

Game can be played with up to 10 persons.

Objective of game:

To win a prize by having all your cards called and be the first one to get rid of all the cards in your hand.



Instructions:

Presenter, shuffle Hepatitis C cards. Deal out all of the Hepatitis C cards, including jokers, to all players. Have everyone look at their cards and know what they have in their hands. Some persons may end up with a few more cards than others.

Presenter, shuffle the regular deck of cards with the jokers included. Place your regular deck face down in front of you.

Presenter, flip the top card over and call out the name of the card. Example: 5 of ♣ clubs. Whoever has the 5 of ♣ clubs will tell the rest of the group what is printed on their Hepatitis C card then place it face down in front of them. Example: 5 of ♣ clubs “Factors that influence treatment response include age, gender, genotype, viral load, general liver health and strict adherence to your prescription dosage and scheduling”. Flip over second card on the deck and call out that card just as you did with first. Again, who ever has that card will have to say out loud what is printed on their card then place it face down in front of them. Continue to repeat calling out cards until someone in the group throws down their last card that they hold in their hand. Once they say what is on the card, they must say that they are educated about Hepatitis C. That person wins a prize.

Retrieve all the remaining cards from participants and play again if you like.
