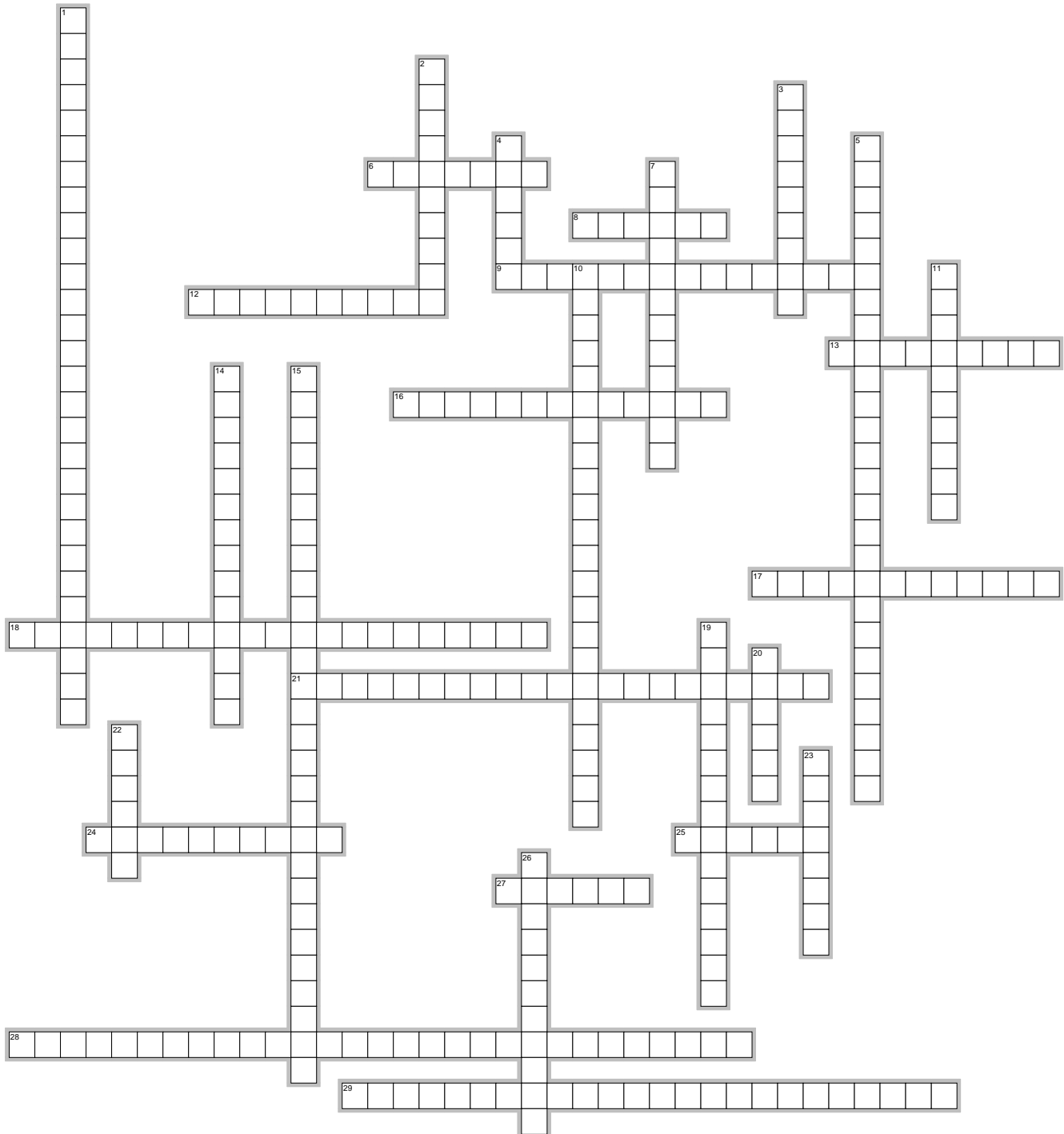


Hepatitis C Crossword Puzzle # 3
